No. GYC/1/2018/PRV/102007/2180/A:- In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution of India, and in supersession of all the rules made in this behalf, the Governor of Gujarat hereby makes the following rules to provide for regulating the recruitment to the post of Archaeological Chemist, Class II under the Directorate of Archaeology and Museum, Gujarat State in the General State Service, namely:-

1. These rules may be called the Archaeological Chemist, Class II, under the Directorate of Archaeology and Museum, Recruitment Rules, 2018.
2. Appointment to the post of Archaeological Chemist, Class II in the General State Service, under the Directorate of Archaeology and Museum, shall be made either, -
  - (a) by promotion of a person of proved merit and efficiency from amongst the persons, who -
    - (i) have worked for not less than seven years in the cadre of Assistant Archaeological Chemist Class III, ; and
    - (iii) have passed the qualifying examination for computer knowledge in accordance with the provisions of the

or

(b) by direct selection.

3. To be eligible for appointment by direct selection to the post mentioned in rule 2, a candidate shall –

(a) not be more than 42 years of age;

Provided further that the upper age limit may be relaxed in favour of a candidate who is already in the service of the Government of Gujarat in accordance with the provisions of the Gujarat Civil Services Classification and Recruitment (General) Rules, 1967.

Provided further that nothing contained in clause (b) of sub-rule (9) of rule 8 of the Gujarat Civil Services Classification and Recruitment (General) Rules, 1967 shall be applicable in so far as relaxation of upper age limit as prescribed above is concerned.

(b) possess, -

(i) a degree of B.Sc. (Chemistry) with second class obtained from any of the Universities established or incorporated by or under the Central or a State Act in India ; or any other educational institution recognized as such or declared to be deemed as a University

under section 3 of the University Grants Commission Act, 1956 and have about seven years experience on the post not below the rank of Laboratory Assistant, Class III under the Directorate of Archaeology and Museum or have about seven years experience of Chemical Processing in chemistry laboratory of Government / Government Undertaking / Board / Corporation / Local Bodies / Limited Company established under Companies Act, 2013 / a Private chemistry laboratory recognized by National Accreditation Board of Laboratories on the post which can be considered equivalent to the post not below the rank of Laboratory Assistant, Class III, under the Directorate of Archaeology and Museum ;

- (ii) A degree of M.Sc (Chemistry) with second class obtained from any of the Universities established or incorporated by or under the Central or a State Act in India or any other educational institute recognized as such or declared to be deemed as a University under section 3 of the University Grants Commission Act, 1956 and have about five years' experience on a post not below the rank of Laboratory Assistant, Class III under the Directorate of Archaeology and Museum or

have about five years' experience of Chemical Processing in chemistry laboratory of Government / Government Undertaking / Board / Corporation / Local Bodies / Limited Company established under Companies Act, 2013 / a Private chemistry laboratory recognized by National Accreditation Board of Laboratories on the post which can be considered equivalent to the post not below the rank of Laboratory Assistant, Class III under the Directorate of Archaeology and Museum.

(c) possess basic knowledge of computer application as prescribed

in the the Gujarat Civil Services Classification and

Recruitment (General) Rules, 1967.

(d) have successfully completed a six months Certificate Course on Conservation of Cultural Property at NRLC (National Research Laboratory for Conservation of Cultural Property) or in recognized institution

(e) possess adequate knowledge of Gujarati or Hindi or both.

4. The candidate appointed by direct selection shall be on probation for a period of two years.

5. The candidate appointed by direct selection shall, during his probation period be required to undergo pre-service training and pass the post- training examination in accordance with the Gazetted Officers Pre-service Training and Examination Rules, 1970.
  6. The candidate appointed by direct selection shall, during his probation period be required to pass the qualifying examination for computer knowledge in accordance with the Gujarat Civil Services Computer Competency Training and Examination Rules, 2006.
  7. The candidate appointed by direct selection shall be required to pass an examination in Gujarati or Hindi or both in accordance with the rules prescribed by the Government.
  8. The candidate appointed by direct selection or by promotion shall have to undergo such training and pass such examination as may be prescribed by the Government.
  9. The candidate appointed by direct selection shall be required to furnish security and surety bond in such form for such amount and for such period as may be prescribed by Government.
