CONSTITUTION OF INDIA.

NO.GP/28/DNT/1011/2253/V:- In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution of India and in supersession of all the rules made in this behalf, the Governor of Gujarat hereby makes the following rules to provide for regulating recruitment to the post of Professor, Class I, in the General State Service, in the dental subjects mentioned in Annexure annexed to these rules at the Government Dental Colleges and Hospitals under the Commissionerate of Health, Medical Service and Medical Education and Research, Gujarat State; namely :-

1. These rules may be called the Professor, Class I, in the dental subject in the Government Dental Colleges and Hospitals Recruitment Rules, 2015.
2. In these rules, unless the context otherwise requires;
 - (i) "Dental candidate" means a candidate possessing the degree of B. D. S. of University established in India by law and recognised by Dental Council of India and having registration under the State or Central Law pertaining to and requiring Dental Registration.
 - (ii) "Annexure" means annexure appended to these rules.
 - (iii) "Equivalent qualification" means the qualification as recognised by the Dental Council of India.

3. Appointment to the post of Professor, Class-I, in the General State Service in the dental subjects mentioned in Annexure at the Government Dental Colleges and Hospitals under the Commissionerate of Health, Medical Services and Medical Education and Research, Gujarat State shall be made either,

(a) by promotion on the basis of principle of selectivity within the zone of consideration irrespective of seniority in accordance with the provisions of the Gujarat Civil Services Classification Recruitment (General) Rules, 1967 from amongst persons, who-

(i) have worked for not less than five years in the cadre of Reader or Associate Professor, Class-I, in General State Service, in the concerned subject at the Government Dental Colleges and Hospitals under the Commissionerate of Health, Medical Services and Medical Education and Research, Gujarat State;

(ii) have passed the qualifying examination for computer knowledge in accordance with the provisions of the Gujarat Civil Services Computer Competency Training and Examination Rules, 2006; and

(iii) possesses the educational qualification as prescribed in clause (b) of rule 4 for direct selection, or

(b) by direct selection.

4. To be eligible for appointment by direct selection to the post mentioned in rule 3, a candidate shall-

(a) not be more than 45 years of age.

Provided that the upper age limit may be relaxed in favour of a candidate who is already in the service of the Government of Gujarat in accordance with the provisions of the Gujarat Civil Services Classification and Recruitment (General) Rules, 1967.

(b) possess

(i) academic qualifications as specified respectively against each subject in Annexure obtained from any of the Universities established or incorporated by or under the Central or State Act in India, or any other educational institution recognised as such or declared to be deemed as University under section 3 of the University Grants Commission Act, 1956; or possess an equivalent qualification recognised by the Dental Council of India;

(ii) the basic knowledge of computer application as prescribed in the Gujarat Civil Services Classification and Recruitment (General) Rules, 1967; and

(iii) adequate knowledge of Gujarati or Hindi or both.

(c) have at least five years teaching experience in the concerned subject as specified in column 2 of Annexure on the post of Reader or Associate Professor, Class I, in the Dental College/ Medical College recognised by the Government and Dental Council of India after acquiring the post-graduate degree.

5. The candidate appointed by direct selection shall be on probation for a period of two years.

6. The candidate appointed by direct selection shall, during his probation period, require to undergo pre-service training and to pass the post training examination in accordance with the provisions of the Gazetted Officer's (Pre-Service Training and Examination) Rules, 1970.

7. The candidate appointed by direct selection shall, during his probation period, require to pass the qualifying examination for computer knowledge in accordance with the provision of the Gujarat Civil Services Computer Competency Training and Examination Rules, 2006.

8. The candidate appointed by direct selection shall require to pass the examination in Hindi or Gujarati or both in accordance with the rules prescribed by the Government.
9. The candidate appointed by direct selection shall be required to get him self-registered in a State or Central Dental Register under the Dental Council Act, 1948 at the time of application for direct selection, if he is not so registered.
10. A candidate appointed either by promotion or by direct selection shall require to undergo such training and pass such examination as may be prescribed by the Government.
11. The candidate appointed by direct selection shall require to furnish a security and surety bond in such form, for such amount and for such period as may be prescribed by the Government.

6	Orthodontics and Dentofacial Orthopedics.	B.D.S. with M.D.S. in Orthodontics and Dentofacial Orthopedics or Diplomate of National Board in Orthodontics and Dentofacial Orthopedics.
7	Periodontology.	B.D.S. with M.D.S. in Periodontology or Diplomate of National Board in Periodontology.
8	Oral Pathology and Microbiology.	B.D.S. with M.D.S. in Oral Pathology and Microbiology or Diplomate of National Board in Oral Pathology and Microbiology.
9	Public Health Dentistry.	B.D.S. with M.D.S. in Public Health Dentistry or Diplomate of National Board in Public Health Dentistry.
