**Gujarat Police
Act, 1951.**

No. GG/ 05 /2017/DYS/102014/515143/B :- In exercise of the powers conferred by the section 5 of the Gujarat Police Act, 1951 (Bom.XXII of 1951) and in supersession of all the rules made in this behalf, the Government of Gujarat hereby makes the following rules to provide for regulating recruitment to the post of Police Inspector (Unarmed), Class II, in the Gujarat State Police Service, namely :-

1. These rules may be called the Police Inspector (Unarmed), Class II, Recruitment Rules, 2017.
2. Appointment to the post of Police Inspector (Unarmed), Class II, in the Gujarat State Police Service shall be made either,-
 - (a) by promotion of a person of proved merit and efficiency from amongst the persons, who-
 - (i) have worked for not less than seven years in the cadre of Police Sub-Inspector (Unarmed), Class III, in the subordinate service of the Police Department;
 - (ii) have passed the departmental examination as may be prescribed by the Government;
 - (iii) have passed the qualifying examination for computer knowledge in accordance with the provisions of the Gujarat Civil Services Computer Competency Training and Examination Rules, 2006;
 - (iv) possess valid driving licence for Light Motor Vehicle;

(v) have passed the physical efficiency test as may be prescribed by the Government;

(vi) have worked combined or separately for not less than one year in the Cadre of Police Sub-Inspector (Unarmed), Class III (excluding the period of leave, training, etc.) in the branches or wings such as Intelligence or C.I.D.(Crime) or State Control Room or Police Computer Centre or Home Guards or Prohibition and Excise wing or Civil Defense or Training of Police Organisation in the Gujarat Police Service.

Provided that the sub -clause (vi) shall come into force after four years from the date of publication of this notofication in the *Official Gazette*.

Provided further where the appointing authority is satisfied that a person having the experience specified in sub-clause (i) above is not available for promotion and that it is necessary in the public interest to fill up the post by promotion even of a person having experience for a lesser period; it may, for reasons to be recorded in writing, promote such person who possesses experience of a period of not less than two-thirds of the period specified in sub-clause (i) above ; or

(b) by direct selection, on the basis of the result of competitive examination for recruitment to the Post of Police Inspector, Class II, held by the Gujarat Public Service Commission.

3. Appointments by direct selection, on the basis of the result of competitive examination and promotion shall be made in the ratio of 1:4, respectively.

4. To be eligible for appointment by direct selection, on the basis of the result of competitive examination to the post mentioned in rule 2, a candidate shall-

(a) not be more than 35 years of age;

(b) possess,-

(i) a Bachelor's degree obtained from any of the Universities established or incorporated by or under the Central or a State Act in India; or any other educational institution recognised as such or declared to be deemed as a University under section 3 of the University Grants Commission Act, 1956;

(ii) the basic knowledge of computer application as prescribed in the Gujarat Civil Services Classification and Recruitment (General) Rules, 1967;

(iii) the minimum requisite standards of physique as specified in Appendix appended to these rules;

(iv) a valid light motor vehicle driving license on the date of appointment;

(v) adequate knowledge of Gujarati or Hindi or both.

5. The candidate appointed by direct selection, on the basis of the result of competitive examination shall be on probation for a period of two years.

6. The candidate appointed by direct selection, on the basis of the result of competitive examination shall during his probation period require to,-

- (i) undergo pre-service training and pass the post-training examination in accordance with the provisions of the Gujarat Police Inspector (Training) Order, 2017;
- (ii) pass an examination in accordance with the provisions of the Gujarat Probationary Police Inspector (Departmental Examination) Rules, 2017;
- (iii) pass an examination in accordance with the provisions of the Gujarat Civil Services Computer Competency Training and Examination Rules, 2006; and
- (iv) undergo the Commando Training successfully as may be prescribed by the Government .

7. The candidate appointed by direct selection on the basis of the result of competitive examination shall require to pass an examination in Gujarati or Hindi or both in accordance with the rules prescribed by the Government.

8. The candidate appointed either by direct selection on the basis of the result of competitive examination or by promotion shall require to undergo such training and pass such examination as may be prescribed by the Government.

9. The candidate appointed by direct selection on the basis of the result of competitive examination shall furnish a security and surety bonds in such form, for such period and for such amount as may be prescribed by the Government.

10. Where in respect of any matter regarding service conditions of the Police Inspector (Unarmed), Class II for which specific provision is not made either in the Act or in these rules, the following rules as

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ammended from time to time which are applicable to the employees of the corresponding class of Government of Gujarat, shall, *mutatis-mutandis*, apply to the Police Inspector (Unarmed), Class II, whom these rules are applicable, namely:-

1. The Gujarat Civil Services Classification and Recruitment (General) Rules, 1967.
2. The Gujarat Civil Services (Pay) Rules, 2002.
3. The Gujarat Civil Services (Additions to Pay) Rules, 2002.
4. The Gujarat Civil Services (General Conditions of Services) Rules, 2002.
5. The Gujarat Civil Services (Travelling Allowance) Rules, 2002.
6. The Gujarat Civil Services (Occupation of Government Residential Accomodation) Rules, 2002.
7. The Gujarat Civil Services (Leave) Rules, 2002.
8. The Gujarat Civil Services (Pension) Rules, 2002.
