No.GP/08/HMC/102019/183/CHH: In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution of India, and in supersession of all the rules made in this behalf, the Governor of Gujarat hereby makes the following rules to provide for regulating recruitment to the post of Deputy Director (Homoeopathy), Class I, in the General State Service, under the Directorate of AYUSH (Ayurveda, Yoga and Naturopathy, Unani, Siddha and Homoeopathy), namely:-

1. These rules may be called the Deputy Director (Homoeopathy), Class I, in the General State Service, under the Directorate of AYUSH (Ayurveda, Yoga and Naturopathy, Unani, Siddha and Homoeopathy), Recruitment Rules, 2020.

2. Appointment to the post of Deputy Director (Homoeopathy), Class I, in the General State Service, under the Directorate of AYUSH (Ayurveda, Yoga and Naturopathy, Unani, Siddha and Homoeopathy), shall be made either;

(a) by promotion of a person who possess 'Very Good bench mark' for being considered fit for promotion as laid down in the Gujarat Civil Services Classification and Recruitment (General) Rules, 1967 from amongst the persons, who;

(i) have worked for not less than five years in the cadre of Assistant Director (Homoeopathy), Class I in the Directorate of AYUSH (Ayurveda, Yoga and Naturopathy, Unani, Siddha and Homoeopathy); and

(ii) have passed the qualifying examination for computer knowledge in accordance with the provisions of the

Gujarat Civil Services Computer Competency Training and Examination Rules, 2006.

Provided that where the appointing authority is satisfied that a person having experience specified in sub-clause (i) above is not available for promotion and that it is necessary in the public interest to fill up the post by promotion even of a person having experience for a lesser period ; it may , for reasons to be recorded in writing , promote such person who possesses experience of a period of not less than two-thirds of the period specified in sub-clause (i) above; or

(b) by direct selection.

3. To be eligible for appointment by direct selection to the post mentioned in rule 2, a candidate shall,-

(a) not be more than 44 years of age:

Provided that the upper age limit may be relaxed in favour of the candidate who is already in the service of the Government of Gujarat in accordance with the provisions of the Gujarat Civil Services Classification and Recruitment (General) Rules, 1967.

Provided further that nothing contained in clause (b) of sub-rule (9) of rule 8 of the Gujarat Civil Services Classification and Recruitment (General) Rules, 1967 shall be applicable in so far as relaxation of upper age limit as prescribed above is concerned.

(b) possess a Post Graduate degree in Homoeopathy in one of the subjects included in the second Schedule of the Homoeopathic Central Council Act, 1973 obtained from any

of the Universities established or incorporated by or under the Central or a State Act in India ; or any other educational institution recognised as such or declared to be deemed as a University under section 3 of the University Grants Commission Act, 1956 ; and

- (c) have about seven years teaching/administrative/clinical experience in Homoeopathy in Government/Government undertaking /Charitable Institute/Private Homoeopathy College/ Homoeopathy Hospital (except self/own managed Hospital) on the post which can be considered equivalent to the post not below the rank of Resident Medical Officer (Homoeopathy)/ Medical Officer (Homoeopathy), Class II, under the Directorate of AYUSH (Ayurveda, Yoga and Naturopathy, Unani, Siddha and Homoeopathy).
- (d) possess the basic knowledge of computer application as prescribed in the Gujarat Civil Services Classification and Recruitment (General) Rules 1967; and
- (e) possess adequate knowledge of Gujarati or Hindi or both.
4. The candidate appointed by direct selection shall be on probation for a period of two years.
 5. The candidate appointed by direct selection, during his probation period, shall be required to undergo pre-service training and pass the post-training examination in accordance with the provisions of the Gazetted Officers Pre-service Training and Examination Rule, 1970.
 6. The candidate appointed by direct selection during his probation period, shall be required to pass the qualifying

examination for computer knowledge in accordance with the provisions of the Gujarat Civil Services Computer Competency Training and Examination Rules, 2006.


7. The candidate appointed by direct selection shall be required to pass an examination in Hindi or Gujarati or both in accordance with the rules prescribed by the Government.

8. The candidate appointed either by direct selection or by promotion shall be required to undergo such training and pass such examination as may be prescribed by the Government.

9. The candidate appointed by direct selection shall be required to get himself registered under the Gujarat Homoeopathic Council under the Gujarat Homoeopathic Act, 1963 at the time of his application for direct selection, if he is not so registered.

10. The candidate appointed by direct selection shall be required to furnish a security and surety bond in such form, for such amount and for such period as may be prescribed by the Government.
