

- (b) have passed the Higher Secondary School Certificate Examination from Secondary and Higher Secondary Education Board with Physics, Chemistry and English subjects;
  - (c) possess a certificate of having passed prescribed X-Ray Technician Training Course conducted by the Government Institute or a recognised medical college;
  - (d) possess the basic knowledge of computer application as prescribed in the Gujarat Civil Services Classification and Recruitment (General) Rules, 1967; and
  - (e) possess adequate knowledge of Gujarati or Hindi or both.
4. The provisions of rule 9A of the Gujarat Civil Services Classifications and Recruitment (General) Rules, 1967 shall be applicable in respect of a candidate appointed by direct selection.
  5. The candidate appointed by direct selection or promotion shall require to undergo such training and pass such examination as may be prescribed by the Government.

#### CONSTITUTION OF INDIA.

**NO.GU/2017/03/BRT/102007/2623/D-1.--** In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution of India and in supersession of all the rules made in this behalf, the Governor of Gujarat hereby makes the following rules to provide for regulating recruitment to the post of Technical Advisor (Chemical), Class I, in the Gujarat Industrial Service, under the Commissionerate of Industries, Gujarat State, namely:-

1. These rules may called the **Technical Advisor (Chemical), Class I, in the Commissionerate of Industries, Recruitment Rules, 2017.**
2. Appointment to the post of **Technical Advisor (Chemical), Class I, in the Gujarat Industrial Service, under the Commissionerate of Industries, Gujarat State, shall be made by direct selection.**
3. To be eligible for appointment by direct selection to the post mentioned in rule 2, a candidate shall,-
  - (A) not be more than 47 years of age:  
Provided that the upper age limit may be relaxed in favour of a candidate who is already in the service of the Government of Gujarat in accordance with the provisions of the Gujarat Civil Services Classification and Recruitment (General) Rules, 1967;
  - (b) possess-
    - (i) a Master Degree in Chemical Engineering or Petro-chemical Engineering or Petroleum Engineering obtained from any of the Universities established or incorporated by or under the Central or a State Act in-India; or any other educational institution recognised as such or declared to be deemed as a University under section 3 of the University Grants Commission Act, 1956; or
    - (ii) an M.Sc. degree in Industrial Chemistry (after Graduation in B.Sc. Engineering) from IIT;
  - (c) have about 10 years' experience in the field of Environment Protection, Pollution Control, Chemical, Petrochemical, Oil Refining or Oil and Gas Industries.in the Government or Government Undertaking, Board, Corporation, Local Body, Limited Company established under the Companies Act 2013 or in the Government Project, out of which 3 years' experience on the post which can be considered equivalent to the post not below the rank of Class I, in the Gujarat State Service;

- (d) possess the basic knowledge of computer application as prescribed in the Gujarat Civil Services Classification and Recruitment (General) Rules, 1967; and
- (e) possess adequate knowledge of Gujarati or Hindi or both.
4. The candidate appointed by direct selection shall be on probation for a period of two years.

1. These rules may be called the Joint Technical Advisor (Precision Instruments), Class I in the Gujarat Industrial Service, Recruitment Rules, 2017.
2. Appointment to the post of Joint Technical Advisor (Precision Instruments), Class I in the Gujarat Industrial Service, under the Commissionerate of Industries, Gujarat State, shall be made by direct selection.
3. To be eligible for appointment by direct selection to the post mentioned in rule 2, a candidate shall,-
  - (1) not be more than 45 years of age:
 

Provided that the upper age limit may be relaxed in favour of a candidate who is already in the service of the Government of Gujarat in accordance with the provisions of the Gujarat Civil Services Classification and Recruitment (General) Rules, 1967;
  - (2)
    - (I) (i) have a Bachelor's degree in Engineering or Technology with first class (excluding Civil Engineering or Technology) obtained from any of the Universities established or incorporated by or under the Central or a State Act in India; or any other educational institution recognised as such by the Government or declared to be deemed as a University under section 3 of the University Grants Commission Act, 1956; and
    - (ii) have post-graduate degree in Engineering or Technology (excluding Civil Engineering or Technology); or:
      - (a) Master's Degree in Business Administration;

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- (c) Degree or Diploma in Post-Graduate Programme in Management of minimum two years duration obtained from any of the Universities established or incorporated by or under the Central or a State Act in India; or any other educational institution recognised as such by the Government or declared to be deemed as a University under section 3 of the University Grants Commission Act, 1956; and
- (iii) (a) have about eight years' experience on the post not below the rank of Industries Officer (Technical), Class II, or Industries Officer, Class II in the subordinate services under the Gujarat Industrial Service, Gujarat State, or;
- (b) have about eight years' combined or separate experience in relevant field of engineering or administration in the Government, Government Undertaking, Board, Corporation or Limited Company established under the Companies Act, 2013 on the post which can be considered equivalent to the post not below the rank of Industries Officer (Technical), Class II, or Industries Officer, Class II in the subordinate services under the Gujarat Industrial Services, Gujarat State; or
- (II) have Doctorate (Ph.D.) Degree in Engineering or Technology (excluding Civil Engineering or Technology) obtained from any of the University established or incorporated by or under the Central or a State Act in India; Or any other educational institution recognised as such or declared to be deemed as a University under section 3 of the University Grants Commission Act, 1956 ; and
- (A) have about five years' experience on the post not below the rank of Industries Officer (Technical), Class II, or Industries Officer, Class II in the subordinate services under the Gujarat Industrial Services, Gujarat State, or;
- (B) have about five years' separate or combined experience in relevant field of engineering or administration in the Government, Government Undertaking, Board, Corporation or Limited Company established under the Companies Act, 2013 on the post which can be considered equivalent to the post not below the rank of Industries Officer (Technical), Class II, or Industries Officer, Class II in the subordinate services under the Gujarat Industrial Services, Gujarat State; and
- (3) possess the basic knowledge of computer application as prescribed by the Gujarat Civil Services Classification and Recruitment (General) Rules, 1967;
- (4) possess adequate knowledge of Gujarati or Hindi or both.
4. The candidate appointed by direct selection shall be on probation for a period of two years.
