No:GSH/2011/ 144/SBE/10-2010/755548/M(1):- In exercise of the powers conferred by proviso to article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Gujarat hereby makes the following rules to provide for regulating recruitment to the post of Technical Officer, in the Gujarat Boilers Service, Class II, namely:-

1. These rules may be called the Technical Officer, Class II, Recruitment Rules, 2011.
2. Appointment to the post of Technical Officer, in the Gujarat Boiler Service, Class II, shall be made either, -

(a) by promotion of a person of proved merit and efficiency from amongst the persons who, -

(i) have worked for not less than seven years in the cadre of Senior Technical Assistant, Class III, in the subordinate service of the Commissionerate of Labour; and

(ii) have passed the qualifying examination for computer knowledge in accordance with the provisions of the Gujarat Civil Services Computer Competency Training and Examination Rules, 2006:

Provided that where the appointing authority is satisfied that a person having the experience specified in sub-clause (i) above is not available for promotion and that it is necessary in the public interest to fill up a post by

promotion even of a person having experience for a lesser period; it may, for reasons to be recorded in writing, promote such person who possesses experience of a period of not less than two thirds of the period specified in sub-clause (i) above; or

(b) by direct selection.

3. To be eligible for appointment by direct selection to the post mentioned in rule 2, a candidate shall, -

(a) not be more than ³⁷30 years of age:

Provided that the upper age limit may be relaxed in favour of a candidate who is already in the service of the Government of Gujarat in accordance with the provisions of the Gujarat Civil Services Classification and Recruitment (General) Rules, 1967;

(b) possess, -

→ a bachelor's degree
(i) a degree in Mechanical Engineering obtained from any of the Universities established or incorporated by or under the Central or State Act in India; or any other educational institution recognized as such by the Government or declared as deemed to be University under section 3 of the University Grants Commission Act, 1956; or ~~possess an equivalent qualification recognized by the Government, and~~

(A) have about two years experience on the post not below the rank of Junior Technical Assistant, Class III, in the subordinate service of the Commissionerate of Labour; or

- (B) have about two years experience of working as a Mechanical Engineer, out of which, about one year combined or separate experience in design or construction or repairs or operation or maintenance of land Boilers and allied steam engines or turbines in the Government or local bodies or Government undertaking Board or Corporation or Industrial Organization; or
- (ii) a diploma in Mechanical Engineering obtained from any of the Universities established or incorporated by or under the Central or State Act in India; or any other educational institution recognized as such by the Government or declared as deemed to be University under section 3 of the University Grants Commission Act, 1956; ~~or possess an equivalent qualification recognized by the Government,~~ and
- (A) have about five years experience on the post not below the rank of Junior Technical Assistant, Class III, in the subordinate service of the Commissionerate of Labour; or
- (B) have about five years experience of working as a Mechanical Engineer, out of which, about three years' combined or separate experience in design or construction or repairs or operation or maintenance of land Boilers and allied steam engines or turbines in the Government or local bodies or Government undertaking Board or Corporation or Industrial Organization;
- (c) possess the basic knowledge of computer application as prescribed in the Gujarat Civil Services Classification and Recruitment (General) Rules, 1967;
- (d) possess the adequate knowledge of Gujarati or Hindi or both.

4. The candidate appointed by direct selection shall be on probation for a period of two years.
5. The candidate appointed by direct selection shall, during his probation period, require to pass the qualifying examination for computer knowledge in accordance with the provisions of the Gujarat Civil Services Computer Competency (Training and Examination) Rules, 2006.
6. The candidate appointed by direct selection shall, during his probation period, require to undergo pre-service training and pass the post-training examination in accordance with the Gazetted Officers' (Pre-service Training and Examination) Rules, 1970.
7. The selected candidate shall require to pass the departmental examination and an examination in Hindi or Gujarati or both in accordance with the rules prescribed by the Government.
8. The candidate appointed either by direct selection or by promotion shall have to undergo such training and pass such examination as may be prescribed by the Government.

9. The candidate appointed by direct selection shall require to furnish a security and surety bond in such form, for such amount and for such period as may be prescribed by the Government.

No.GSH/2020/111/SBI/102010/255548/M(1) : In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Gujarat hereby makes the following rules further to amend the Technical Officer, Class II, Recruitment Rules, 2011, namely :

1. These rules may be called the Technical Officer, Class II, Recruitment (Amendment) Rules, 2020.
2. In the Technical Officer, Class II, Recruitment Rules, 2011, (herein after referred to as "the said rules"), in rule 2, in clause (a) for the words "by promotion of a person of proved merit and efficiency" the words and figures "by promotion of a person who possess "good" benchmark for being considered fit for promotion within zone of consideration as laid down in the Gujarat Civil Services Classification and Recruitment (General) Rules, 1967" shall be substituted.
3. in the said rules in rule 3; -
 - (1) for clause (a) the following shall be substituted namely:
"(a) not be more than 37 years of age.

Provided that the upper age limit may be relaxed in favour of a candidate who is already in the service of the Government of Gujarat in accordance with the provisions of the Gujarat Civil Services Classification and Recruitment (General) Rules, 1967.

Provided further that nothing contained in clause (b) of sub-rule (9) of rule 8 of the Gujarat Civil Services Classification and Recruitment (General) Rules

1967 shall be applicable in so far as the relaxation of upper age limit as prescribed above is concerned."

- (2) In clause (b) in sub-clause (i) (i) for the words "a degree", the words "a bachelor's degree" shall be substituted.
- (ii) the words "or possess an equivalent qualification recognized by the Government" shall be deleted.
- (3) In clause (b) in sub-clause (ii) the words "or possess an equivalent qualification recognized by the Government" shall be deleted.
