CONSTITUTION OF INDIA.

No. GH/V/151 of 2002/BRT-1091-833-V :—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution of India, and in supersession of the all previous rules made in this behalf except the things done or omitted to be done the Governor of Gujarat hereby makes the following rules to provide for regulating recruitment to the post of Town Planner Class-I in the Town Planning and Valuation Department, namely:-

1. These rules may be called the Town Planner Class-I (Town Planning and Valuation Department) Recruitment Rules, 2002.
2. Appointment to the post of Town Planner Class-I in the Town Planning and Valuation Department shall be made either
  - (a) by promotion of a person of proved merit and efficiency from amongst the persons who have worked for not less than eight years in the cadre of Junior Town Planner Class-II, in Town Planning and Valuation Department; or
  - (b) by direct selection
3. The appointment by promotion and by direct selection shall be made in the ratio of 2:1 respectively.
4. To be eligible for appointment by direct selection to the post mentioned in rule-2, a candidate shall -

(a) Not be more than 37 years of age;

Provided that the upper age limit may be relaxed in favor of a candidate who is already in the service of the Government of Gujarat in accordance with the provisions of the Gujarat Civil Services Classification and Recruitment (General) Rules, 1967 as amended from time to time. Provided further that the upper age limit may also be relaxed in favour of a candidate possessing exceptionally good qualifications or experience or both.



(b) possess -

(i) A degree in Architecture or Civil Engineering from a university established by law in India or its equivalent qualification from an Institution recognised by the Government.

(ii) Post graduate degree or post-graduate diploma in City Planning or Town Planning or Traffic and Transportation Planning or Regional Planning or Urban Design awarded by university established by Law in India or by an Institution recognised by the All India Council for Technical Education or a membership obtained by examination of Institution of Town Planners of India, New Delhi;

Provided that preference shall be given to a candidate having the knowledge of relevant Computer Software.

*Five yrs*  
 (c) have about seven years experience on medium or higher level post in the Organizations in the field of Urban or Regional or Traffic and Transportation planning or Urban design gained after obtaining the qualifications specified in sub-clause (b);

(d) possess adequate knowledge of Gujarati or Hindi or both.

5. A candidate appointed by direct selection shall be on probation for a period of two years.

6. A selected candidate shall be required to pass an examination in Hindi or Gujarati or both in accordance with the rules prescribed by the Government in that behalf from time to time.

7. The cadre of Town Planner Class-I shall be comprised of the post belonging to the cadre of Deputy Town Planner Class-I immediately before its discontinuance to the cadre of Deputy Town Planner Class-I and the cadre known as Deputy Town Planner Class-I shall be discontinued with effect on and from the date of notification published in the official gazette.

NO.GH/V/1 of 2009/BRT-1091-833-V PART - In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Gujarat hereby makes the following rules further to amend the Town Planner Class I, (Town Planning and Valuation Department) Recruitment Rules, 2002, namely:-

1 These rules may be called the Town Planner Class I (Town Planning and Valuation Department) Recruitment (Amendment) Rules, 2009.

2 In the Town Planner, Class I (Town Planning and Valuation Department) Recruitment Rules, 2002, ("hereinafter referred to as the said rules") for rule 2, the following rule shall be substituted namely:-

2. Appointment to the post of Town Planner, Class I in the Town Planning and Valuation Department shall be made either, -

(a) by promotion of a person of proved merit and efficiency from amongst the persons who, -

(i) have worked for not less than eight years in the cadre of Junior Town Planner Class II, in Town Planning and Valuation Department.

Provided that where the appointing authority is satisfied that a person having the experience specified above is not available for promotion and that it is necessary in the public interest to fill up the post by promotion even of a person having experience for a lesser period; it may, for reasons to be recorded in writing, promote such person who possesses experience of a period of not less than two-thirds of the period specified in clause (i) above;


(ii) have passed the qualifying examination for computer knowledge in accordance with the provisions of the Gujarat Civil Services Computer Competency Training and Examination Rules, 2006; or

(b) by direct selection.

3. In the said rules, in rule 4, -
- (i) in clause (a), for the figure and word "37 years", the figure and word "35 years" shall be substituted;
  - (ii) in clause (b), after sub-clause (ii), the following sub-clause shall be inserted, namely:-  
"(iii) the basic knowledge of computer application as prescribed by the Gujarat Civil Services Classification and Recruitment (General) Rules, 1967 as amended from time to time,";
  - (iii) in clause (c) for the words "Seven years", the words "five years" shall be substituted.
4. In the said rule after rule 5, the following rule shall be inserted, namely:

"5A. The candidate appointed by direct selection shall, during his probation period, be required to pass the qualifying examination for Computer knowledge in accordance with the provisions of the Gujarat Civil Services Computer Competency Training and Examination Rules, 2006".
