No.(GN-108)-TSM-222008-4197-GH:- In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution of India and in supersession of all the rules made in this behalf, the Governor of Gujarat hereby makes the following rules to provide for regulating recruitment to the post of Accounts Officer, Class I, in the Gujarat Accounts Service, namely :-


1. These rules may be called the Accounts Officer, Class I, Recruitment Rules, 2019.
2. Appointment to the post of Accounts Officer, Class I, in the Gujarat Accounts Service, shall be made either.-
 - (a) by promotion of a person of proved merit and efficiency from amongst the persons, who, -
 - (i) have worked for not less than eight years in the cadre of Accounts Officer, Class II, in the Gujarat Accounts Service; and
 - (ii) have passed the qualifying examination for computer knowledge in accordance with the provisions of the Gujarat Civil Services Computer Competency Training and Examination Rules, 2006;

Provided that where the appointing authority is satisfied that the person having the experience specified in sub-clause(i) above is not available for promotion and that it is necessary in the public interest to fill up the post by promotion even if a person having experience for a lesser period; it may, for reasons to be recorded in writing, promote such person who possesses experience of a period of not less than two-thirds of the period specified in sub-clause(i) above ;

or

- (b) on the basis of result of the competitive examination held for the purpose.
3. The appointment by promotion and on the basis of result of the competitive examination held for the purpose shall be made in the ratio of 3:1.
4. To be eligible for appointment on the basis of the result of the competitive examination held for the purpose to the post mentioned in rule 2, the candidate shall ,—
- (1) not be less than 20 years and not be more than 40 years of age:

Provided that the upper age limit may be relaxed in favour of the candidate who is already in the service of the Government of Gujarat in accordance with the



provisions of the Gujarat Civil Services Classification and Recruitment (General) Rules, 1967;

Provided further that nothing contained in clause (b) of sub - rule (9) of rule 8 of the Gujarat Civil Services Classification and Recruitment (General) Rules, 1967 shall be applicable in so far as relaxation of upper age limit as prescribed above is concerned;

(2) possess , -

(a) a qualification of Chartered Accountant (C.A.) or Cost and Works Accountants(I.C.W.A)/ CMA(Cost and Management Accountant) or Company Secretary(C.S.); or

(b) (i) a degree in Master of Commerce obtained from any of the Universities or institutions established or incorporated by or under the Central or a State Act in India; or any other educational institution recognised as such or declared to be deemed as a University under section 3 of the University Grants Commission Act, 1956; and

(ii) have about three years combine or separate experience of the work related to accounts and audit, in the Government / Government undertaking /Board / Corporation / Local Bodies / University / Banking organisation established by

law / company registered under the Companies Act, 2013/ Chartered Accountant's firm; or

(c) (i) a degree in Bachelor of Commerce obtained from any of the Universities or institutions established or incorporated by or under the Central or a State Act in India; or any other educational institution recognised as such or declared to be deemed as a University under section 3 of the University Grants Commission Act, 1956; and

(ii) have about five years combine or separate experience of the work related to accounts and audit, in the Government/ Government undertaking /Board / Corporation / Local Bodies / University / Banking organisation established by law / company registered under the Companies Act, 2013/ Chartered Accountant's firm;

(d) the basic knowledge of computer application as prescribed in the Gujarat Civil Services Classification and Recruitment (General) Rules, 1967; and

(e) adequate knowledge of Gujarati or Hindi or both.

5. The candidate appointed on the basis of result of the competitive examination shall be on probation for a

period of two years.

6. The candidate appointed on the basis of result of the competitive examination held for the purpose during his probation period shall be required to undergo pre-service training and pass the post-training examination in accordance with the Gazzetted Officer's Pre-service Training and Examination Rules, 1970.
7. The candidate appointed on the basis of result of the competitive examination held for the purpose during his probation period shall be required to pass the qualifying examination for computer knowledge in accordance with the provisions of the Gujarat Civil Services Computer Competency Training and Examination Rules, 2006.
8. The candidate appointed on the basis of result of competitive examination held for the purpose shall be required to pass the departmental examination and an examination in Hindi or Gujarati or both in accordance with the rules prescribed by the Government.
9. The candidate appointed either on the basis of result of the competitive examination held for the purpose or by promotion shall be required to undergo such training and pass such examination as may be prescribed by the Government.
10. The candidate appointed on the basis of result of the competitive examination held for the purpose shall be

required to furnish a security and surety bond in such form, for such amount and for such period as may be prescribed by the Government.
