No: GP/21/NSG/102006/875/E: In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution of India and in supersession of all the rules made in this behalf, the Governor of Gujarat hereby makes the following rules to provide for regulating recruitment to the post of Nursing Officer/Principal Class II (Grade I) in the Nursing School in the Gujarat Nursing Services, under the Commissionerate of Health, Medical Services and Medical Education and Research, Gujarat state namely:-

1. These rules may be called the Nursing Officer/Principal Class II (Grade I) in the Nursing School Recruitment Rules, 2020.
2. Appointment to the post of Nursing Officer/Principal Class II (Grade I) in the Nursing School in Gujarat Nursing Services, under the Commissionerate of Health, Medical Services and Medical Education and Research, Gujarat state shall be made either,-
 - (a) by promotion of a person who possesses " Good" benchmark for being considered fit for promotion within the zone of consideration as laid down in Gujarat Civil Services Classification and Recruitment (General) Rules, 1967 from amongst the persons, who,-
 - (i) have worked for not less than five years in the Cadre of Vice Principal, Class II in the Nursing School in the Gujarat Nursing Services under the Commissionerate of Health, Medical Services and Medical Education and Research; and
 - (ii) have passed the qualifying examination for computer knowledge in accordance with the provisions of the Gujarat Civil Services Computer Competency Training and Examination Rules, 2006;

Provided that where the appointing authority is satisfied that a person having the experience specified in sub-clause (i) above is not available for promotion and it is necessary in the public interest to fill up the post by promotion even of a person having experience for a lesser period; it may, for reasons to be recorded in writing, promote such person who possesses experience of a period of not less than two-thirds of the period specified in sub-clause (i) above; or

(b) by direct selection.

3. The appointment by promotion and by direct selection shall be made in the ratio of 1:2 respectively.

4. To be eligible for appointment by direct selection to the post mentioned in rule 2, a candidate shall,-

(a) not be more than forty years of age:

Provided that the upper age limit may be relaxed in favour of a candidate who is already in the service of the Government of Gujarat in accordance with the provisions of the Gujarat Civil Services Classification and Recruitment (General) Rules, 1967:

Provided further that nothing contained in clause (b) of sub-rule (9) of rule 8 of the Gujarat Civil Services Classification and Recruitment (General) Rules, 1967 shall be applicable in so far as relaxation of upper age limit as prescribe above is concerned;

(b) possess,-

(i) a degree of M.Sc (Nursing) obtained from any of the University established or incorporated by or under the Central or a State Act in India; or any other educational institution recognised as such or declared to be deemed as a University under Section 3 of the


University Grants Commission Act, 1956 and recognized by the Indian Nursing Council and have 3 years teaching experience in the recognised Nursing College/Nursing School/Training Institution of Nursing; or

- (ii) a degree of Post Basic B.Sc. (Nursing)/ Basic B.Sc. (Nursing) obtained from any of the University established or incorporated by or under the Central or a State Act in India or any other educational institution recognised as such or declared to be deemed as a University under section 3 of the University Grants Commission Act, 1956 and recognised by the Indian Nursing Council and have 5 years teaching experience in the recognised Nursing College/Nursing School/Training Institution of Nursing.
- (c) possess the basic knowledge of computer application as prescribed in Gujarat Civil Services Classification and Recruitment (General) Rules, 1967; and
- (d) possess adequate knowledge of Gujarati or Hindi or both.
5. The candidate appointed by direct selection shall be on probation for a period of two years.
6. The candidate appointed by direct selection during his probation period, shall be required to pass the qualifying examination for computer knowledge in accordance with the provisions of the Gujarat Civil Services Computer Competency Training and Examination Rules, 2006.
7. The candidate appointed by direct selection during his probation period, shall be required to undergo pre-service training and pass the post-training examination in accordance with the provisions of the Cazetted Officer's Pre-Service Training and Examination Rules, 1970.

8. The candidate appointment by direct selection shall be required to pass an examination in Hindi or Gujarati or both in accordance with the rules prescribed by the Government.
9. The candidate appointed by direct selection shall be registered with the Gujarat Nursing Council as registered Nurse, registered Midwife or in the equivalent cadre under the Gujarat Nurses, Midwives and Health Visitor's Act, 1968, at the time of appointment for direct selection, if not so registered.
10. The candidate appointed either by direct selection or by promotion shall be required to liable to serve in any defense services or post connected with the defense of India, for a period of not a less than four years including a period of any spent on training:
Provided that the candidate shall not be required to serve as aforesaid after the experience of 10 years from the date of his/her appointment;
Provided further that candidate shall not ordinarily be required to serve as aforesaid after attaining the age of forty five years.
11. The candidate appointed either by direct selection or by promotion shall be required to undergo such training and to pass such examination as may be prescribed by the Government.
12. The candidate appointed by direct selection shall be required to furnish a security and surety bond in such form, for such amount and for such period as may be prescribed by the Government.

1. These rules may be called the Nursing Officer / Principal Class II (Grade I) in the Nursing School, Recruitment (Amendment) Rules, 2021.
2. In the Nursing Officer / Principal Class II (Grade I) in the Nursing School Recruitment Rules, 2020 in rule 4, in clause (b), in sub-clause (i) and sub-clause (ii), after the words "Training institution of Nursing", the words "recognised by Indian Nursing Council after obtaining the education qualification as prescribed above on the post not below the rank of Nursing Tutor, Class III in the subordinate service of the Comissionerate of Health, Medical Services, and Medical Education and Research, Gujarat state or on the post which can be considered equivalent to the post not below the rank of aforesaid post of Nursing Tutor, Class III, in the subordinate service of the Comissionerate of Health, Medical Services, and Medical Education and Research" shall be inserted.
