### Revised Frequently Asked Questions regarding Main Written Examination

#### Advertisement No. 39/2017-18

⊕ **IF I HAVE PASSED THE FINAL DEGREE EXAMINATION AFTER PRELIMINARY TEST, WOULD I BE ELIGIBLE FOR THE MAIN EXAMINATION ?**

➤ Yes, if the result of final degree examination is declared on or before the last date of application for main examination. As per the provision of rule 13 (2) of the Gujarat Engineering Services (Civil), (Class I and Class II), Competitive Examination Rules, 2017, a candidate who is declared qualified by the Commission for appearing in the Main Examination shall be required to produce proof of passing the degree examination along with their application for the Main Examination. If the candidate fails to produce the proof of passing the degree examination on or before the last date of submission of application shall be disqualified.

⊕ **IS CALCULATOR PERMITTED IN MAIN WRITTEN EXAMINATION?**

➤ As per the provision of rule 2 of the Gujarat Engineering Services (Civil), (Class I and Class II), Competitive Examination (Amendment) Rules, 2018, Non-Programmable Scientific Calculator may be permitted if it's essential to write the answers asked in the question paper, but exchange or transfer of calculator amongst the candidates in the Examination Hall is strictly prohibited.

⊕ **WHETHER CODES WILL BE GIVEN IN THE EXAMINATION HALL ? IF YES, WHICH CODES ?**

➤ **No IS Codes would be provided in the exam. The relevant information (if any) would be mentioned in the Question Paper. Candidates can make relevant assumptions (if necessary) and mention it clearly.**

⊕ **WHETHER THE MARKS OF PRELIMINARY EXAMINATION WILL BE COUNTED IN THE FINAL SELECTION ? HOW THE LIST OF ORDER OF MERIT WILL BE DECIDED?**

➤ Yes, as per the provision of rule 18 of the Gujarat Engineering Services (Civil, (Class I and Class II), Competitive Examination Rules, 2017, the candidates shall be arranged in the order of merit on the basis of the aggregate marks finally awarded to each candidate in the Preliminary Examination and Main Examination (Written and Interview).

⊕ **IF I WOULD BE ABSENT IN THE INTERVIEW, WILL I BE ELIGIBLE FOR FINAL SELECTION ?**

➤ No, as per the provision of rule 19 of the Gujarat Engineering Services (Civil, (Class I and Class II), Competitive Examination Rules, 2017, the candidates who qualifies for the interview but fails to attend it, shall not be eligible for selection.

⊕ **IS THERE ANY OPTION PROVIDED IN DESCRIPTIVE PAPERS?**

➤ No. The detailed paper scheme of main written examination is as under.

1.	ESM1	Gujarati	This question paper contains 11 questions as shown in the syllabus, out of these, question-1 and question-2 contains internal options. Question-3 to question-11 shall be compulsory and shall not have any internal options. In question-11, there shall be question of each topic as shown in the syllabus.

2.	ESM2	English	<p>This question paper contains 8 questions as shown in the syllabus, out of these, question-1 contains internal options. Question-2 to question-8 shall be compulsory and shall not have any internal options. Sub-questions of question-7 are of objective types, the candidate will have to choose the correct answer from given options and will have to write the correct answer in bracket (CAPITAL LETTERS) as well as candidate will have to encode in given circle as shown in the below example. There will not be any negative marking for the wrong answer. Zero marks will be awarded to the question if the answer written by the candidate in the bracket and the answer encoded in the circle differs.</p> <p>Example:</p> <p>1. 3.	ESM3	Civil Engineering-I	<p>This question paper has three sections. There shall be 12 questions each of 05 marks in section A, 08 questions each of 10 marks in section B and, 04 questions each of 15 marks in section C. All questions of section A, B and C shall be compulsory.</p>
4.	ESM4	Civil Engineering-II	<p>This question paper has three sections. There shall be 12 questions each of 05 marks in section A, 08 questions each of 10 marks in section B and, 04 questions each of 15 marks in section C. All questions of section A, B and C shall be compulsory.</p>

5.	ESM5	Civil Engineering- III	This question paper has three sections. There shall be 12 questions each of 05 marks in section A, 08 questions each of 10 marks in section B and, 04 questions each of 15 marks in section C. All questions of section A, B and C shall be compulsory.
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**Note:**

1. The medium of the Question Paper 1 shall be Gujarati and Question Paper 2 shall be English. The medium of the Question Paper 3, 4 and 5 shall be English. In all question papers, questions will be printed in the answer book and space to write the answer shall be provided below the concerned question according to word limit. Candidate has to write the answers in the provided space below the concerned question only and under any circumstances supplementary answer sheet shall not be provided.
2. So far ESM-3, ESM-4 and ESM-5 is concerned, considering the Calculations and Diagrams involved in the answers, for answering the question the candidates should ignore the word limit as prescribed in the syllabus and should adhere to the space allocated. As every question is starting on a new page there would be some excess space available for almost all the questions. Candidates may take note of it.
3. Last three pages would be available for rough work.
