#### Constitution of India.

No. GJ/17 of 2016/RRC/102007/(1)/E-5 :- In exercise of the powers Conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution of India and in supersession of all the rules made in this behalf, the Governor of Gujarat hereby makes the following rules to provide for regulating recruitment to the post of Assistant Engineer (Mechanical), Class II, in the Gujarat Engineering Services under the Narmada, Water Resources, Water Supply and Kalpasar Department, Gujarat State, namely :-

1. These rules may be called the Assistant Engineer (Mechanical), Class II, in the Gujarat Engineering Services, under the Narmada, Water Resources, Water Supply and Kalpasar Department Recruitment Rules, 2016.
2. Appointment to the post of Assistant Engineer (Mechanical), Class II, in the Gujarat Engineering Services, under the Narmada, Water Resources, Water Supply and Kalpasar Department, Gujarat State, shall be made by direct selection.
3. To be eligible for appointment by direct selection to the post mentioned in rule 2, a candidate shall,-

- (a) not be more than 35 years of age:

Provided that the upper age limit may be relaxed in favour of a candidate who is already in the service of the Government of Gujarat in accordance with the provisions of the Gujarat Civil Services Classification and Recruitment (General) Rules, 1967;

- (b) possess,-
- (i) a degree in Engineering (Mechanical) obtained from any of the Universities established or incorporated by or under the Central or a State Act in India; or any other educational institutions recognised as such or declared to be deemed as a University under section 3 of the University Grants Commission Act, 1956;
  - (ii) the basic knowledge of computer application as prescribed in the Gujarat Civil Services Classification and Recruitment (General) Rules, 1967; and
  - (iii) adequate knowledge of Gujarati or Hindi or both.
4. The candidate appointed by direct selection shall be on probation for a period of two years.
  5. The candidate appointed by direct selection shall, during his probation period, require to pass the qualifying examination for computer knowledge in accordance with the provisions of the Gujarat Civil Services Computer Competency Training and Examination Rules, 2006.
  6. The candidate appointed by direct selection shall require to pass the professional examination and an examination in Hindi or Gujarati or both in accordance with the rules prescribed by the Government.
  7. The candidate appointed by direct selection shall require to undergo such training and pass such examination as may be prescribed by the Government.
  8. The candidate appointed by direct selection shall require to furnish a security and surety bond in such form, for such amount and for such period as may be prescribed by the Government.
