CONSTITUTION

OF INDIA.

No. GU/2015/21/BRT/ 102009 / 629 / D-3 In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution of India and in supersession of all the rules made in this behalf, the Governor of Gujarat hereby makes the following rules to provide for regulating recruitment to the post of Geologist, Class I, in the Gujarat Mining Service, namely:-

1. These rules may be called the Geologist, Class I, in the Gujarat Mining Service Recruitment Rules, 2015.
2. Appointment to the post of Geologist, Class I in the Gujarat Mining Service shall be made either:-
 - (a) by promotion of a person of proved merit and efficiency from amongst the person who;
 - (i) have worked for not less than eight years in the cadre of Assistant Geologist, Class II, in Gujarat Mining Service;
 - (ii) have passed the prescribed departmental examination for promotion to the post of Geologist, Class I;
 - (iii) have passed the qualifying examination for Computer knowledge in accordance with the provisions of the Gujarat Civil Services Computer Competency Training and Examination Rules, 2006:

Provided that where the appointing authority is satisfied that a persons having the experience specified in sub clause (i) above is not available for promotion and that it is necessary in the public interest to fill up the post by promotion even of a person having experience for a lesser period; it may, for reasons to be recorded in writing, promote such person who possesses experience of a period of not less than two-thirds of the period specified in sub clause (i) above; or

- (b) by direct selection.

3. The appointments by promotion and by direct selection shall be made in ratio of 1:1.

4. To be eligible for appointment by direct selection to the post mentioned in rule 2, a candidate shall,

(a) not be more than 39 years of age: — 40 (141-C)

Provided that the upper age limit may be relaxed in favour of a candidate who is already in the service of the Government of Gujarat in accordance with the provisions of the Gujarat Civil Services Classification and Recruitment (General) Rules, 1967;

(b) possess,-

(i) a post graduate degree in Geology or applied Geology with minimum 55% marks obtained from any of the Universities established or incorporated by or under the Central or a State Act in India; or any other educational Institution recognized as such or declared to be deemed as a University under section 3 of the University Grants Commission Act, 1956;

(ii) the basic knowledge of Computer application as prescribed in the Gujarat Civil Services Classification and Recruitment (General) Rules 1967;


(iii) adequate knowledge of Gujarati or Hindi or both, (141-C)

(c) (i) have about Three seven years, experience on the post not below the rank of Royalty Inspector, Class III, in the subordinate service of the Commissionerate of Geology and Mining; or

(ii) have about Three seven years, experience in the field of mining or mineral administration or mineral legislation or mineral exploration in Government or Government undertaking Board or Corporation or Limited Company established by Law in India or Mining Organization on the post which can be considered equivalent to the post not below the rank of Royalty Inspector, Class III, in the subordinate service of the Commissionerate of Geology and Mining.

5. The candidate appointed by direct selection shall be on probation for a period of two years.
6. The candidate appointed by direct selection shall, during his probation period required to undergo pre-service training and to pass the post training examination in accordance with the provisions of the Gazetted Officers Pre-service Training and Examination Rules, 1970.
7. The candidate appointed by direct selection shall, during his probation period required to pass the qualifying examination for computer knowledge in accordance with the provisions of the Gujarat Civil Services Computer Competency Training and Examination Rules, 2006.
8. The candidate appointed by the direct selection shall be required to pass examination Hindi or Gujarati or both in accordance with the rules prescribed by the Government.
9. The candidate appointed by the direct selection shall be required to pass the departmental examination as may be prescribed by the Government.
10. The candidate appointed either by promotion or by direct selection shall have to undergo such training and pass such examination as may be prescribed by the Government.
11. The candidate appointed by the direct selection shall be required to furnish a security and surety bond in such form, for such amount and for such period as may be prescribed by the Government.



GU/2019/10/BRT/102009/629/D-3 :- In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Gujarat hereby makes the following rules further to amend the Geologist, Class I, in the Gujarat Mining Service, Recruitment Rules, 2015, namely :-

1. These rules may be called the, Geologist, Class I, in the Gujarat Mining Service, Recruitment (Amendment) Rules, 2019.
2. In the Geologist, Class I, in the Gujarat Mining Service, Recruitment Rules, 2015, in rule 4, in sub-rule (a),-
 - (i) for the figures and word, "39 years", the figures and word "44 years" shall be substituted;
 - (ii) after the existing proviso, the following proviso shall be inserted, namely :-

"provided further that nothing contained in clause (b) of sub - rule (9) of rule 8 of the Gujarat Civil Services Classification and Recruitment (General), Rules, 1967 shall be applicable in so far as relaxation of upper age limit as prescribed above is concerned"


