CONSTITUTION OF INDIA

No. GP-22-ESE-1481-1435-CH.--In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution of India, and in suppression of all rules made in this behalf, the Governor of Gujarat hereby makes the following rules to provide for regulating the recruitment to the post of Deputy Director, in the Gujarat Medical Services, Class-I (Employees' State Insurance Scheme), namely :-

- (1) These rules may be called the Deputy Director, Class-I, (Employees' State Insurance Scheme), Recruitment rules, 2009.
- (2) Appointment to the post of Deputy Director, Class-I shall be made either :-
 - (a) by promotion on the basis of Principal of selectivity within the zone of consideration irrespective of seniority in accordance with the provisions of the Gujarat Civil Services Classification and Recruitment (General) Rules, 1967 from amongst the persons, who,
 - (i) have worked for not less than five years in the cadre of Assistant Director, Class-I (Employees' State Insurance Scheme), and
 - (ii) possess academic qualification as prescribed in clause (b) of rule 3, and
 - (iii) have passed the qualifying examination for Computer Knowledge in accordance with the Provisions of the Gujarat Civil Services Computer Competency Training and Examination Rules, 2006 :-

Provided that where the appointing authority is satisfied that a person having the experience specified in clause (a)(i) above is not available for promotion and that it is necessary in the public interest to fill up the post by promotion even of a persons having experience for a lesser period; it may, for reasons to be recorded in writing, promote such person who possesses experience of a period of not less than two-thirds of the period specified in clause (a)(i) above.

or

- (b) By direct selection.
- (3) To be eligible for appointment by direct selection to the post mentioned in rule 2, a candidate shall-
 - (a) not be more than 40 years of age;

Provided that the upper age limit may be relaxed in favour of a candidate who is already in the services of the Government of Gujarat in accordance with the provisions of the Gujarat Civil Services Classification and Recruitment (General) Rules, 1967.

- (b) possess :-
 - (i) Bachelor of Medicine & Bachelor of Surgery Degree from a statutory University of

India or any other qualification specified in the first and Second Schedule of the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956; and

- (ii) A Post-graduate degree in any branch of Medical Science.
- (c) have atleast 7 years experience in Class I cadre in a medical institution or in Employees' State Insurance Scheme or Medical or Health Department of the Government.
- (d) Possess the basic knowledge of computer application as prescribed in the Gujarat Civil Services Classification and Recruitment (General) Rules, 1967.
- (e) Possess adequate knowledge of Gujarati and/or Hindi.
- (4) The selected Candidate shall require to get him registered under the provisions of the Medical Council Act, 1967 before joining duty, if not already registered.
- (5) The selected Candidate shall be on probation for a period of two years.
- (6) The candidate appointed by direct selection shall during his probation period be required to pass the qualifying examination for computer knowledge in accordance with Gujarat Civil Services Computer Competency Training and Examination Rules, 2006.
- (7) The candidate appointed by direction selection shall, during his probation period, be required to undergo pre-service training and to pass the post training examination in accordance with the Gazetted Officer's Pre-Service Training and Examination Rules, 1970.
- (8) The selected candidate shall require to pass an examination in Hindi or Gujarati or both in accordance with rules prescribed by the Government.
- (9) The candidate appointed either by direct selection or by promotion shall have to undergo such training and to pass such examination as may be prescribed by the Government.
- (10) A candidate appointed by direct selection shall, if so required, be liable to serve in any defence service or post connected with the defence of India, for a period of not less than four years including the period, if any, spent on training provided that the candidate-
- (a) shall not require to serve as aforesaid the expiry of ten years of service from the date of his appointment; and
- (b) shall not ordinarily require to serve as aforesaid after attaining the age of forty five years.
- (11) A candidate appointed by direct selection shall be require to furnish a security and surety bond in such form, for such amount and for such period as may be prescribed by the Government.
