In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, and in supersession of the existing rules for the post of Medical Officer in the Gujarat Medical Services, Class-II and rules and for the post of Medical Officer in the Gujarat Public Health Services, Class-II, the Government of Gujarat hereby makes the following rules to provide for regulating recruitment to the post of Medical Officer Class-II in the integrated cadre of the Gujarat Health Services, namely :-

1. These rules may be called the Medical Officer (Gujarat Health Services) Class-II, Recruitment Rules, 1968.
2. Appointment to the post of Medical Officer in Gujarat Health Services, Class-II shall be made either :
 - (a) by promotion of a person of proved merit and efficiency from amongst the Medical Officer, Class-III who have worked for not less than seven years as Medical Officer, Class-III under Gujarat

recognised by Government of Gujarat or any other qualifications specified in the first or second schedule to the Indian Medical Council Act, 1955 or

- (ii) registrable qualification under the Third schedule to the Indian Medical Council Act, 1955 including such officers who may have been granted exemption under sub-section 1 of Section 30 of the Gujarat Medical Practitioners Act, 1963 (Guj. A of 1964).

Provided that where an appointing authority is satisfied that a person having an experience specified above is not available for promotion and that it is in the public interest to fill-up the post by promotion of a person having experience for a lesser period; it may for reasons to be recorded in writing promote such person who has experience for a period not less than two thirds of the period specified above; or

(b) by direct selection.

- 3. To be eligible for appointment by direct selection to the post mentioned in rule 2, a candidate shall :

(a) be not more than 35 years of age.

(b) possess M.B.B.S. degree of any statutory University in India or any other qualifications specified in the first or second schedule to the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956.

Provided that the upper age limit may be relaxed in favour of a candidate who is already in service of the Government of Gujarat and candidates belonging to Schedule Caste, Schedule Tribes and Socially and Economically Backward Classes in accordance with the provision of the Gujarat Civil Services, Classification and Recruitment (General) Rules, 1967 as amended from time to time.

Provided further that the upper age limit may be relaxed in favour of a candidate possessing exceptionally good qualifications or experience or both.

4. The candidate appointed by direct election shall be on probation for a period of two years.
5. The selected candidates shall be required to pass an examination in Hindi or Gujarati or both in accordance with the rules prescribed by the Government in that behalf, from time to time.

6. The selected candidate shall be required to get himself registered under the Gujarat Medical Council Act, 1967 before joining duty, if he is not so registered.

7. The selected candidate shall be a full time Government servant and shall be debarred from private practice of any kind.

8. The selected candidate shall, if so required be liable to serve in any defence service or post connected with the defence of India for a period of not less than Four years including the period if any spent in Training :

Provided that each candidate,

(a) shall not be required to serve as aforesaid after the expiry of ten years from the date of his appointment ;

(b) shall not ordinarily be required to serve as aforesaid after attaining the age of forty-five years.

9. The selected candidate shall during his probation period be required to undergo training and pass the post-training examination in accordance with the provisions of the Gazetted Officer (Pre-service Training and Examination) Rules, 1979, at a period from time to time.

CONSTITUTION OF INDIA.

No. : GP-2/2007-GHS-1005-535-T :- In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Gujarat hereby makes the following rules further to amend the Medical Officer (Gujarat Health Services) Class-II, Recruitment Rules, 1988, namely :-

1. These rules may be called the Medical Officer (Gujarat Health Services) Class-II, Recruitment (1st Amendment) Rules, 2007.
2. In the Medical Officer (Gujarat Health Services) Class-II, Recruitment Rules, 1988 (hereinafter referred to as "the said rules"), in rule 2, in sub rule (a), after the clause (ii), the following new clause shall be added, namely :-

"(iii) who have passed the qualifying examination for computer knowledge in accordance with the provision of the Gujarat Civil Services Classification and Recruitment (General) Rules, 1967 as amended from time to time."
3. In the said rules, in rule 3, after sub-rule (b), the following new sub-rule shall be added, namely :-

"(c) possess the basic knowledge of Computer application as prescribed in Gujarat Civil Services Classification and Recruitment (General) Rules, 1967 as amended from time to time".
